INFORMATON SECURITY POLICY OF STATISTICS LITHUANIA

Aware of the importance of security of the processed data and statistical information under preparation, Statistics Lithuania undertakes when drafting, disseminating, coordinating and developing national official statistics:

1. to ensure secure statistical data collection, processing and dissemination of statistical information prepared on the basis thereof;
2. to carry on activity taking into account key principles of information security – confidentiality, integrity and availability, in order to ensure information provided by respondents and interested parties;
3. to protect data of the Integrated Statistical Information System from illegal disclosure or unauthorised dissemination;
4. to ensure vulnerability management of the Integrated Statistical Information System;
5. in case of security breach of the Integrated Statistical Information System to evaluate the damage, to limit its consequences and adopt the necessary remedial measures, to ensure measures for the continuity of activities;
6. to strengthen international and interinstitutional cooperation in the field of information security, to actively participate on this issue in the statistical activities of the European statistical system and international organisations, to ensure secure exchange of information;
7. to strive for fulfilment of the objectives aimed to ensure the security of the Integrated Statistical Information System;
8. to regularly update the technical means used to ensure information security, to allocate other resources necessary for proper functioning of the information safety management system;
9. to develop skills and capacities of the Statistics Lithuania's staff in the field of information security;
10. to ensure steady cycle of the safety management of the Integrated Statistical Information System by conducting annual security audit of the Integrated Statistical Information System;
11. to regularly update objectives targeted to ensure information security in view of the annual risk analysis results;
12. to continuously improve the information security management system, its efficiency, by ensuring the implementation of standards LST EN ISO/IEC 27001:2017 and other requirements established for Statistics Lithuania, to apply European good practice.
